The VW Werktour

We visited the Wolfsburg Volkswagen Factory. It is the largest manufacturing plant in the world. The VW Factory was built from the end of 1930. It is one of the largest employers in Lower Saxony. About 70,000 people work there. The Wolfsburg plant produced 815,000 cars per year. In one part of the factory is still production. The other part is a kind of a museum. It called "Autostadt". Each year about 200,000 people come to Wolfsburg to visit the VW plant.

The VW Werkstour lasted about an hour. We didn't have to walk. We drove with a panoramic train through different areas of car manufacturing. So we had the opportunity to get a direct insight into the different production steps of car production. For example we seen the areas of press shop, car construction and final assembly.
