

Serveball - rules

1. INTRODUCTION

- EACH TEAM CONSIST OF 6 PLAYERS.
- THE COURT IS THE SAME AS IN BASKETBALL.
- IN OUR MATCHES A GAME WILL LAST FOR 8 MINUTES.
- YOU SCORE GOALS USING THE BASKETBALL HOOPS.
- ONLY VOLLEYBALL SERVE IS ALLOWED WHEN PASSING.
- THE TEAM WITH THE MOST POINTS WINS.

2. HOW THE GAME BEGINS.

- THE GAME BEGINS WHEN ONE PLAYER FROM EACH TEAM JUMP TO HIT THE BALL TO THEIR TEAMMATES. ONCE THE BALL HAS BEEN HIT, ALL PLAYERS CAN RUN FOR THE BALL.
- THE GAME CANNOT BEGIN BEFORE THERE ARE EVEN NUMBER OF PLAYERS OF EACH END OF THE COURT.
- ONCE A PLAYER HAS RECIEVED THE BALL, HE IS NOT ALLOWED TO TAKE ANY MORE STEPS, JUST PIVOT. TO PASS THE BALL TO TEAMMATES, AN UNDERARM VOLLEYBALL SERVE IS USED.
- SPREAD TO MAKE IT EASY TO PASS.

3. SCORING

- WHEN EVERY PLAYER ON THE TEAM HAS TOUCHED THE BALL – YOU CAN TRY TO SCORE.
- YOU CAN SCORE IN THE BASKETBALL RING OF YOUR CHOICE USING ONLY A VOLLEYBALL HIT.
- INCORRECT SCORING OR PASSING MEANS CHANGE OF POSSESION. PLAYERS MUST STAND AMINUMUM OF 2 METRES FROM THE PERSON PLAYING THE BALL.
- AFTER SCORING, THE OPPOSING TEAM CAN START FROM THE MIDDLE WHEN THEY ARE READY, AND THE SAME RULE APPLIES WITH EACH TEAMMATE TOUCHING THE BALL BEFORE SCORING.
